



Zumo 590 – How to Import third party .gpx files


#1 Connect Zumo to computer, the screen below should show up on computer screen.




#2 Click "Open Device to view files" the screen below appears.



#3 Double click "Internal Storage" as above which then open the file screen below.



#4 Double Click the “GPX” folder.



#5 Copy and Paste your .gpx route file(s) into the GPX folder

#6 Disconnect zumo from computer.

#7 Turn zumo on.

#8 Zumo will advise “New routes found. Import to trip planner?” Answer No

#9 Select / Open “Apps”

#10 Select / Open “Trip Planner”

#11 Select / Open menu (top left 3 horizontal bars)

#12 Select “Import”

#13 Select route by name, then select “Import”, a tick will show against name.

(Suggest only import one route at a time a to stop any potential route file corruption.)

#14 Open “Trip Planner” to check if route has imported and select route, then select map.
